

THINGS TO KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

Protect Purdue campus departure guidelines

Virtually all Purdue classes and final exams will be conducted remotely after Thanksgiving. Residence halls and dining courts will remain open for students who need to be on campus after Thanksgiving. Other campus building hours may be limited.

BEFORE YOU LEAVE

- **If you want to be tested for COVID-19 before you leave**, schedule an appointment with the Protect Purdue Health Center now. Allow 48-72 hours to receive results.
- **Students: Prepare now for return-to-campus testing in January:**
 - **Students living in University Residences and Fraternity, Sorority and Cooperative Life houses should pick up a COVID-19 test before leaving campus.** Take the kit home with you and follow the instructions on the box to complete the test within 14 days before returning to campus in January; the test should be completed no sooner than Jan. 5, 2021.
 - **All other students will be tested by PPHC when they return.**

WHILE YOU'RE AWAY

- **Follow the Protect Purdue Pledge** — masking, social distancing, monitoring for symptoms daily, etc. **Call PPHC at 833-571-1043** 24/7 if you are experiencing any symptoms.

WHEN YOU RETURN

- **If you are returning to campus between Thanksgiving and winter break**, please get tested when you return — especially if you have been in any situation that raises the risk of contracting COVID-19. Schedule a test with PPHC. Visit protect.purdue.edu for instructions.
