

SURVEILLANCE TESTING

FALL 2021

During the fall 2021 semester, Boilermakers have a choice in how to Protect Purdue:

PROTECT PURDUE®



GET VACCINATED

Get fully vaccinated against COVID-19, submit proof by August 13 at vaccine.purdue.edu and be excused from surveillance testing.

FIND A LIST OF APPROVED VACCINES AT PROTECT.PURDUE.EDU

If you are fully vaccinated after August 13, please submit your proof of vaccination at vaccine.purdue.edu to be excused from future surveillance testing. Allow approximately 2 weeks to be removed from the surveillance testing pool.

OR

GET TESTED

Participate in routine surveillance testing — which could be as frequent as weekly — beginning August 23.

If you have chosen not to be vaccinated against COVID-19, keep an eye on your purdue.edu email for instructions on how and when to report for surveillance testing.

Exemptions:

- Employees working 100% remotely.
- Anyone with a positive COVID-19 test result on file with the Protect Purdue Health Center (for 90 days after the test date).

If you miss your surveillance testing appointment, you can expect the consequences to be:

STUDENTS

First time	Conduct warning
Second time	Probated suspension
Third time	Suspension

FACULTY

First time	Written warning
Second time	Final written warning + exclusion from campus
Third time	Unpaid leave

STAFF

First time	Written warning
Second time	Final written warning + exclusion from campus
Third time	Termination
